Family & Youth Support:

Located at the Neighbourhood Centre in Narrabri (53-55 Maitland St) but serving the whole shire, our family and youth support ranges from one-to-one engagement to small group skills programs. You don't need to be in crisis to access our service, we exist to help expectant parents, sole parents, family groups, and young people (up to 24yrs) navigate life's challenges to achieve their goals.

Our Family and Youth workers offer:

- Somebody to talk to and support you and your family
- Small-group skills programs in the areas of parenting and family skills
- Support to set and achieve goals
- Support over the phone, in your town or at the Neighbourhood Centre
- Information on parenting, health, child development, behavioral issues, education and child protection
- Link you into other services (e.g. child health, counselling, employment services etc.)



Located at 30 Maitland St Narrabri, the NDCAS Youth Centre (YC) is a safe space for high school age people to study, learn everyday skills, set and work towards goals for now and the future and to have fun.

Youth Centre staff aim to support young people achieve their goals in both professional and creative ways.

The NDCAS Youth Centre offers:

- A friendly and safe space
- Someone to talk to and support you
- Living-skills spaces and training
- Self-confidence programs
- Self-control programs
- Information and connection to additional supports and services
- Dedicated study and training rooms
- Recreation activities

Early Childhood:

Located at 51 Tibbereena St Narrabri, the Namoi Toy Library is home to our toy borrowing service and Busy Little Hands at Play supported playgroup. These services offer fun and practical support for families as they navigate the important early years of childhood.
