NDCAS Families & Youth

NDCAS Families & Youth Service serves the whole shire. Our family and youth support ranges from one-to-one engagement to small group skills programs. You don't need to be in crisis to access our service, we exist to help expectant parents, sole parents, family groups, and young people (*up to 24yrs*) navigate life's challenges to achieve their goals.

Busy Little Hands at Play– Supported Playgroup is held at 51 Tibbereena Street, Narrabri every Thursday (excluding school holidays and public holidays) from 10am until 12pm. Playgroup offers a supportive environment for children and their parents.

The Namoi & Wee Waa Toy Library supports childhood development by offering parents and carers a large variety of educational toys, puzzles and games available for borrow from the Toy Library on Thursdays between 9am and 2pm. Our Toy Library service outreaches to Wee Waa, Pilliga and Gwabegar once a week to cater to for all your age appropriate toy borrows.

Narrabri Homelessness Support

Narrabri Homelessness Support Service provides essential services to individuals and families at risk or experiencing homelessness. NHSS aims to provide assistance to clients through the provision of intensive long term and short term support, interagency coordination and collaboration, case management and supported referrals.

The Women & Children's Refuge offers short term emergency accommodation for women and children who are homeless as an outcome of domestic violence and/or other at risk factors. The Refuge also provides an outreach service to support clients in maintaining their current accommodation, reducing homelessness.
