Eligibility:

The competition is open to people of all ages and all cultures.

Theme:

Artwork must reflect the themes:

- “ALL IN”
- “50 Years of Deadly”

Artists are encouraged to creatively express what these themes mean to them, their community, culture, identity, Country, family, or lived experiences.

Accepted Artwork:

Participants may:

- Paint
- Draw
- Use recycled or natural materials
- Use canvas, paper, wood, or other creative surfaces

Artwork must be original and created by the entrant within the 8th of June 2026 and the 10th of July 2026.

Key Dates:

Competition Opens: 8th June 2026

Artwork Submission Deadline: 10th July 2026

Late entries will not be accepted.

How to Enter:

Artwork must be delivered to the NDCAS office by the submission deadline.

Each artwork must include:

- Artist name
- Age
- Contact details
- Title of artwork
- Short description of the artwork and how it connects to the competition theme

Judging & Voting:

Community voting will be conducted online.

Prizes:

Winners will receive:

- A Why Leave Town Gift Card
- Their artwork to be proudly displayed at NDCAS

Prizes are not transferable or exchangeable for cash.

Artwork Display & Promotion:

By entering the competition, entrants agree that:

- NDCAS may photograph and display submitted artwork online, on social media, in promotional material, and within community exhibitions.
- NDCAS may discuss with the artist regarding the use of elements within their artwork in its publications.
- Artists will be credited where possible.
- Copyright remains with the artist.

Artwork Collection:

Artists are responsible for collecting their artwork after the exhibition period unless otherwise arranged.

NDCAS is not responsible for uncollected artwork after a reasonable collection period.

Responsibility & Care:

All reasonable care will be taken with submitted artwork; however, NDCAS accepts no responsibility for loss, theft, or damage during transport, handling, display, or storage.

Cultural Respect:

NDCAS encourages respectful and culturally safe artwork submissions. Any artwork considered offensive, discriminatory, inappropriate, or copied from another artist may be removed from the competition.
